



## Kids Voting Presidential Preference Election February 5th, 2008

Kids Voting Arizona is providing the opportunity for every school in Arizona to participate in the 2008 Presidential Preference Election. Kids Voting Arizona will provide curriculum and activities, ballots and other materials and support to minimize the cost and work of conducting the election on your campus. Preparing kids to be active and engaged citizens is crucially important to sustaining our democratic republic, and Kids Voting provides kids on your campus with a relevant opportunity to experience the power of casting a ballot.

1. The first step after determining that your school will participate in the Kids Voting Arizona Presidential Preference Election is to contact Kids Voting Arizona by faxing the enclosed form to (602) 416-7462 or:

2. Kids Voting Arizona will send your school a packet of Kids Voting activities as well as Kids Voting registration cards for each student in your school. You must contact Kids Voting Arizona **by January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2008**.
3. You may select one of three options to enable the students in your school to vote:
  - i. Online: Students can use their voter registration cards immediately until 7pm on February 5<sup>th</sup> to cast a ballot through the Kids Voting Arizona website.
  - ii. Mail-in Ballot: Kids Voting Arizona will provide ballots for each student at your school. You can mail completed ballots to Kids Voting Arizona, or arrange for Kids Voting to pick up your completed ballots. All ballots must be received by 7pm on February 5<sup>th</sup>.
  - iii. Polling Place: Although there are a limited number of Arizona schools with polling places, a campus polling place can be set up in your library, media center or gym. Kids Voting Arizona will provide polling place materials and ballots, and will work with your campus to arrange polling place volunteers if needed.
4. Through a generous contribution by the Phoenix Association of Realtors, at the conclusion of the election Kids Voting will supply your campus with "I voted" stickers for each student casting a ballot.
5. Kids Voting will share the results of the election with your campus.
6. Students are eligible to vote in the General Election on November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2008!
